DAY 1: ARRIVE LOS ANGELES

DAY 2: LOS ANGELES - REAGAN LIBRARY - PISMO BEACH

The library also features the Air Force One used by President Reagan. DAY 4: MONTEREY - CARMEL

Then climb the scenic foothills of the Sierra Nevada Mountains & arrive at your overnight accommodations near Yosemite National Park for a two night stay. Enjoy dinner this evening with your fellow travelers in the Yosemite area.
